Glance at Market of Dental & Oral Health:


The global dental equipment market revenue is expected to increase from USD 6,081.4 million in 2013 to USD 8,453.7 million by 2020, growing at a CAGR of 4.9% from 2014 to 2020.

According to the State Agency "Invest in Spain", the country's rank as for investment climate is among the highest in the world, being the 6th largest recipient of FDI inflows and 3rd in the EU. The global dental equipment market is predicted to exhibit a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 9% to reach over \$13 billion by 2016, The dental equipment market is fuelled not only by the prevention and treatment of disease, but also in large part by cosmetic dentistry, which sees an annual expenditure of \$2.75 billion in the US alone. Tooth whitening procedures attest to soaring demand for cosmetic dentistry,


with a 300% increase over the past five years. The global dental implants market is expected to grow from \$3.2 billion in 2010 to \$4.2 billion in 2015 at a CAGR of 6% from 2010 to 2015. Europe currently forms the world's largest market for dental implants with a 42% market share, and is also expected to have the highest CAGR 7.0% from 2010 to 2015. [8]
