Importance & Scope

Global burden of pediatric mortality is increasing drastically every year. WHO estimates that 8.8 million deaths occur annually among infant and children < 5 years of age. 3.8 million in the first 30 days of life 36% of neonatal deaths due to infectious diseases. Nearly 9 million children under five die every year. Reflecting this imperative, we believe that professionally-oriented education in pediatric infectious diseases is essential in the training of clinicians and clinical academics who will provide the future leadership in this key area for global health. Why San Antonio?

It is being acknowledged that the leading cause for infants and children in San Antonio was for conditions originating in the perinatal period (the times shortly before and shortly after birth) accounting for about 9.5 deaths per 100,000 people. Examples of perinatal difficulties include feeding problems in the newborn, birth trauma, infections, etc.

The second most common cause of death was congenital malformations, deformation and chromosomal abnormalities (for example, poorly developed circulatory or respiratory systems, etc. (about 8.8 per 100,000).

The third most common cause of death is other abnormal clinical and laboratory findings (for example, abnormal heartbeat, breathing problems, tremors, persistent fever, etc.) (8.2 per 100,000).

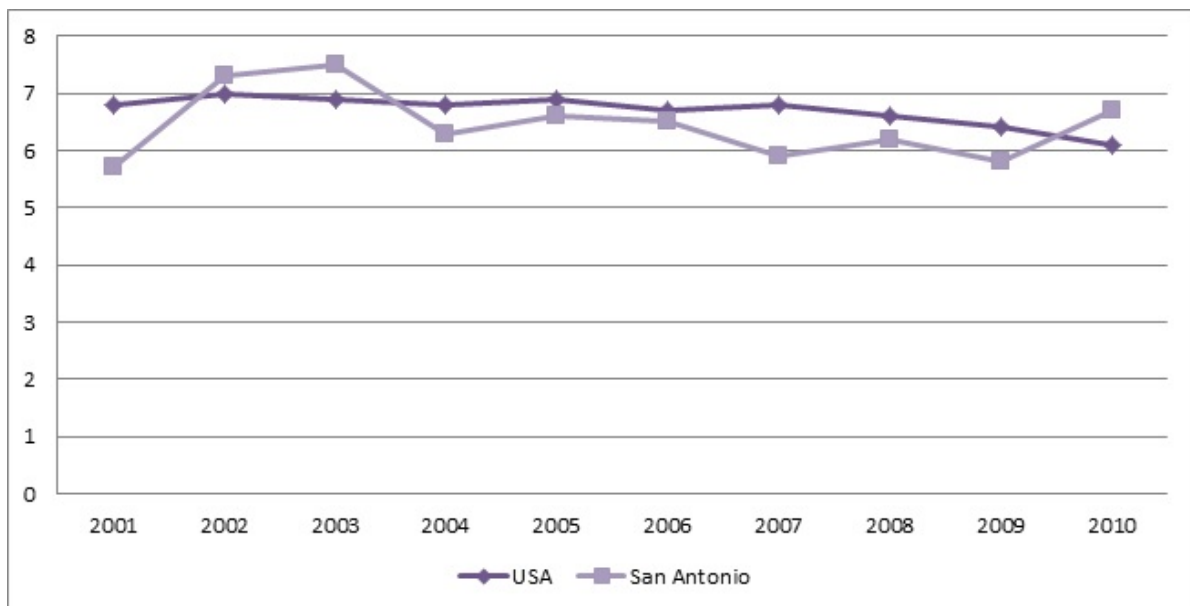


Figure 1: Infant Mortality rate in San Antonio and USA

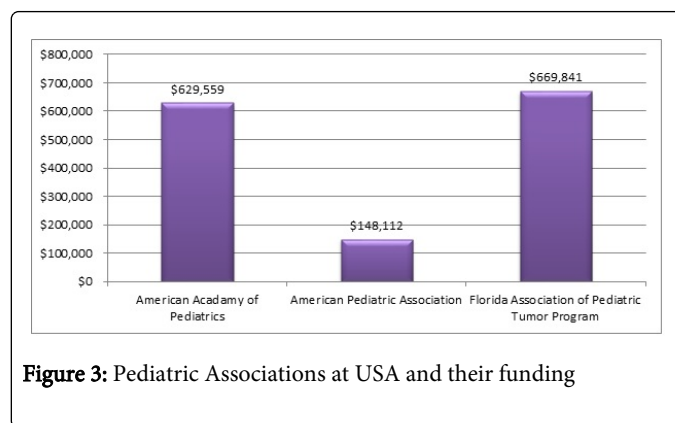


Figure 3: Pediatric Associations at USA and their funding

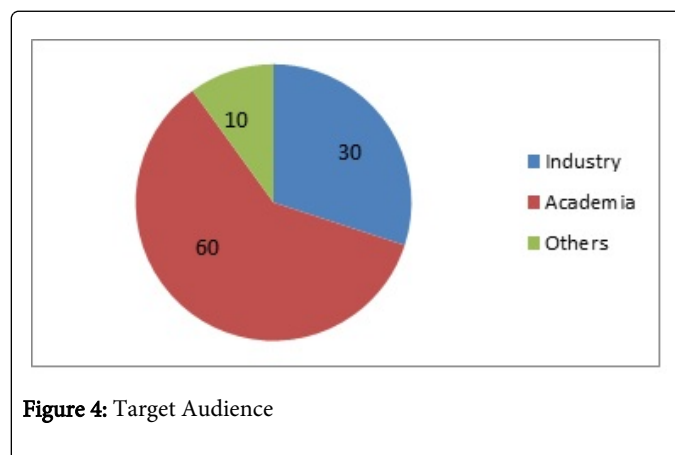


Figure 4: Target Audience

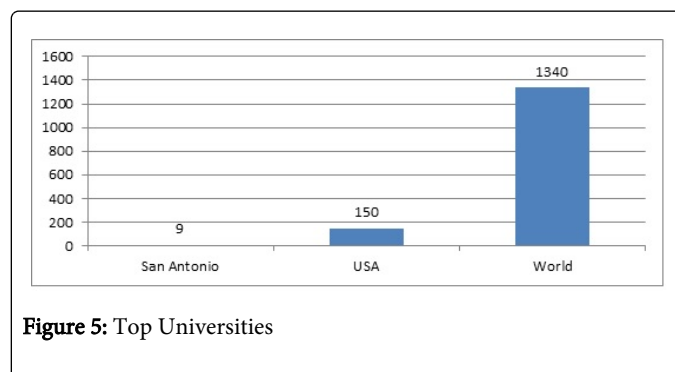


Figure 5: Top Universities

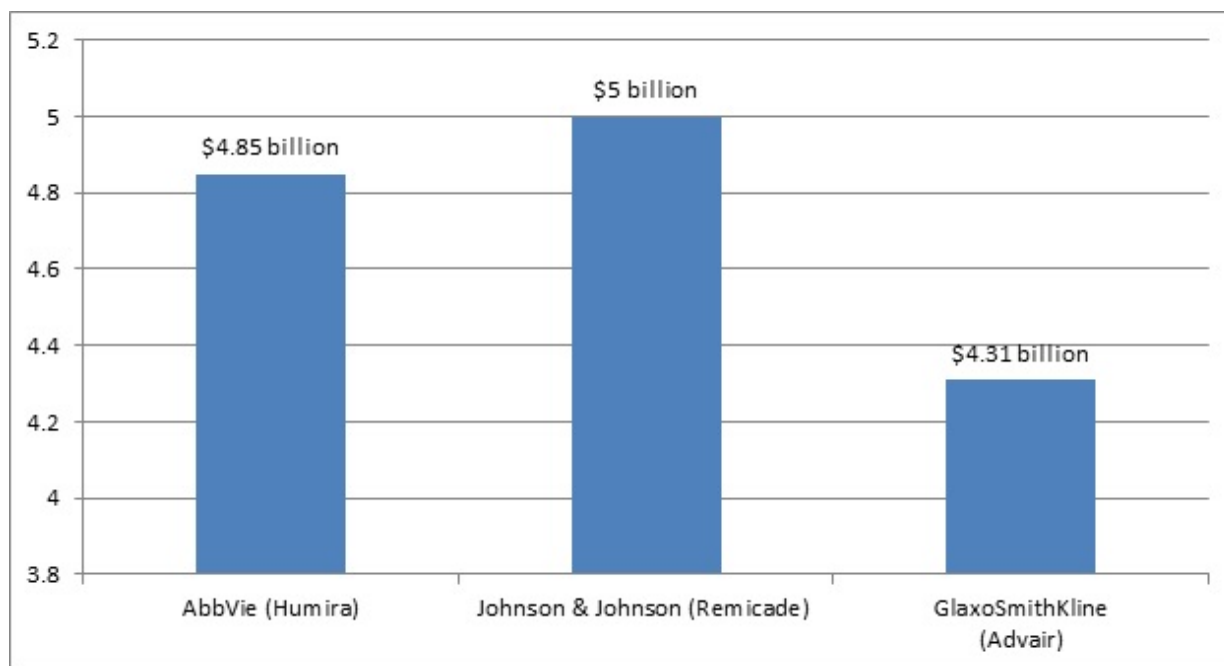


Figure 7: Industries Associated with Pediatric Drugs and their funding

Glance at Market of Pediatrics Health Care:

Children often suffer from short term diseases related to respiratory or ocular infections. Apart from these, gastrointestinal infections accompanied by diarrhea and injury related disorders are common in children. Many times these are just short term diseases and treated on daily basis by pediatricians but treatment of these diseases consume large amount of time and financial resources of their parents and caregivers involved in primary care. Change in lifestyle has been a major factor for increased prevalence of such diseases.

Global pediatric healthcare market is expected to grow at CAGR of 7.2% from \$65.8 billion in 2010 to \$81 billion by 2013. At the same time chronic illness segment is expected to show CAGR of 8.6% and reach \$59 billion market in 2013 from \$46 billion in 2010. The growing demand of treatment options for chronic illness makes the pediatric healthcare market lucrative to invest, and this report helps to gain heads on the in depth analysis of various developments, market trends, drivers, restrains, opportunities , sales forecast and competitive landscape in this market.

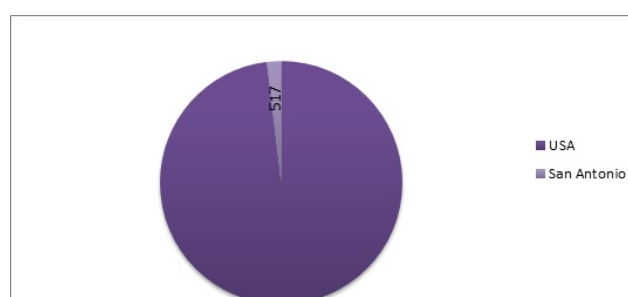


Figure 9: People at San Antonio and USA
