

Statistical Analysis of Associations







Target Audience








Hospital associated with Stress




Glance at Market of Stress and related areas

The stress medicine producing industries have been enjoying strong revenues, with a good rebound since the global recession as per statistics of 2008. Citopram, Fluoxetine, Amitriptyline and Dosulepin are the top four antidepressant which are widely used globally. Eli Lilly, AstraZeneca, Johnson & Johnson, Bristol-Meyers Squibb, GlaxoSmithKline and Pfizer are some major stress drugs producing industries and are generating revenue of 4.70 \$ billion, 4.45 \$ billion, 3.8 \$ billion, 2.15 \$ billion, 1.27 \$ billion and 1.01 \$ billion.





Figure 8: Statistics of funding on stress in different states of USA (14)
