




Figure 2: Top Pharma universities




Figure 3: Companies Associated with Pharma activities


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Glance at UK Pharma market:

There are certain key Pharmaceutical organizations in uk for eg: GlaxoSmithKline and AstraZeneca, Universities and Associations like European Commission-Pharmacovigilance Spanish Society of Clinical Pharmacology, The Pharmaceutical Information and Pharmacovigilance Association and European Medicines Agency, which draw major attention in the field of pharma. UK ranks sixth in the pharmaceutical marketing. pharmaceutical market in Europe with a market size of \$22.7 billion. The london market registered a Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of ~4.4 per cent during CY2007-CY2011. The revenue of the london generic pharma market stood at \$2.20 billion in 2010, which is expected to reach \$7.19 billion in 2017, at a CAGR of 18.4 per cent from 2010 to 2017. The market is dominated by branded medicines with a share of about 88 per cent value wise which makes london one of the important destinations.




Figure 5: Most Pharmacists Country wise




Figure 6: Least Pharmacists Country wise
