About Bali

Bali is an island and province of Indonesia. It is located at the western most end of the Lesser Sunda Islands, between Java to the west and Lombok to the east. Its capital, Denpasar, is located in the southern part of the island. Bali is a part of the Coral Triangle, the area with the highest biodiversity of marine species. In this area over 500 reefs building coral species can be found, which is approximately about 7 times as many as in the entire Caribbean.

Sandy coastlines, mountainous tropical forests, island of flowers, temples, surfing, scuba diving, spas, distinctive culture and friendly people makes Bali, one of the best tourist destination in Indonesia.

Tourism business makes up 80% of its economy. It is renowned for its highly developed arts, including traditional and modern dance, sculpture, painting, leather, metalworking, and music.

Approximately three million tourists (not including Indonesian nationals) visited Bali in 2013, constituting its primary economic resource and affirming its reputation as an international vacation destination. In addition, the ministry of tourism hopes to achieve a 15% increase in foreign arrivals by 2019, suggesting Bali is unlikely to see any curb in growth in the near future. An expensive large-scale endeavor, nourishment projects are not solution but only treatments for an eroding shoreline. In a developing country such as Indonesia, there exists a serious opportunity cost for undergoing such an intensive unsustainable projects. These funds could be utilized for needs in education and public services. With a better understanding of local coastal dynamics, community leaders hold the power to apply sound coastal and riparian zoning practices, possibly initiating a paradigm shift for the island, providing a lasting impact on how the island perceives sustainable coastal management.
