About Philadelphia

Philadelphia is the only World Heritage City in the United States, is the largest city in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the fifth-most-populous in the United States. In the North eastern United States, at the confluence of the Delaware and Schuylkill River, Philadelphia is the economic and cultural centre of the Delaware Valley.

The total parkland amounts to about 10,334 acres (41.82 km²) Philadelphia's largest park, Fairmount Park, encompasses 9,200 acres (37 km²) of this parkland and includes 63 neighbourhood and regional parks. The largest tract of Fairmount Park is on the west side of the city along the Schuylkill River and Wissahickon Creek and includes the Philadelphia Zoo. The liberty bell has long been a symbol of freedom and independence in the United States. It went on tour around the country in the late 19th C in an effort to inspire a sense of freedom and conquer divisions left by the Civil War. The bell completed its journey in Philadelphia in 1915, where it has remained. This Fine Arts Museum features a strong collection of American Art from the 18th, 19th, and 20th Centuries, including works by early American artist's right through to Andy Warhol. The academy is also known for being the oldest of its kind in the United State. South of Walnut Street and east of Washington Square, contains a unique blend of 18th Century buildings, restored warehouses, new homes, colonial homes, and apartments. Some of these are occupied by galleries and other tourist friendly retailers.
