Winter in Atlanta runs from November through to March and the coldest months are December, January and February, when daytime temperatures are around 12 degrees Celsius / 53° degrees Fahrenheit and nighttime temperatures can drop below freezing. December through April can see wet weather and a chilly climate. Even snowfall may also occur during this season, usually between December and January.
