About London

London is the capital and most populous city of England and the United Kingdom. Standing on the River Thames in the south east of Great Britain, London has been a major settlement for two millennia. It was founded by the Romans, who named it Londinium. London's ancient core, the City of London, largely retains its 1.12-square-mile (2.9 km²) medieval boundaries and in 2011 had a resident population of 7,375, making it the smallest city in England.

Although the weather may still be quite cold, the first signs of spring appear in March. It's a good month to visit Kew Gardens, or any of London's other top gardens, as the lawns are covered in purple and white crocuses. Two major spring events on the river Thames happen this month. The weather gradually begins to improve in March in London, UK when the spring season is beginning. At this time of the year, the capital experiences an average temperature of around 8°C which increases as the month develops.

March Events

The St Patrick's Day celebrations, including a parade through central London and a festival in Trafalgar Square, is a celebration of Irish culture, food, dancing and traditional music, and is free to attend. Many pubs and bars around the capital will also host St Patrick's Day parties, and make sure to check out London's best Irish pubs for the best atmosphere.
