## **About Las Vegas, USA**

The name Las Vegas was given to the area in 1829 by a Mexican scout named Raphael Rivera, a member of the Antonio Armijo trading party that was traveling to Los Angeles, and stopped for water there while heading north and west on the Old Spanish Trail from New Mexico. At that time, several parts of the valley contained artesian wells surrounded by extensive green areas; Las Vegas means the meadows in Spanish. The flows from the wells fed the Las Vegas Wash, which runs to the Colorado River. It's a town whose story has been told a huge number of times, in books, for example, "Fear and Loathing in Las Vegas," films, for example, "Casino" and TVs appears from "Vega\$" to "Vegas." Las Vegas is a big museum town in its own way. There is the Neon Museum, a stunning pile of obsolete signage, from vast casinos, for example, the Stardust and Moulin Rouge to roadside motel dice or the grinning shirt advertising a dry cleaner. At the Mob Museum, you can see Kefauver's court, where mafiosos testified before senators, as well as the bullet-riddled brick wall from the St. Valentine's Day Massacre. The National Atomic Testing Museum has history, science and bombs. At the Pinball Hall of Fame, you can admire and play hundreds of games. Dream of driving the 1932 Rolls-Royce Phantom II at the Auto Collections or check out Gypsy Rose Lee's g-string at the Burlesque Hall of Fame or visit the new Polaroid Museum.
