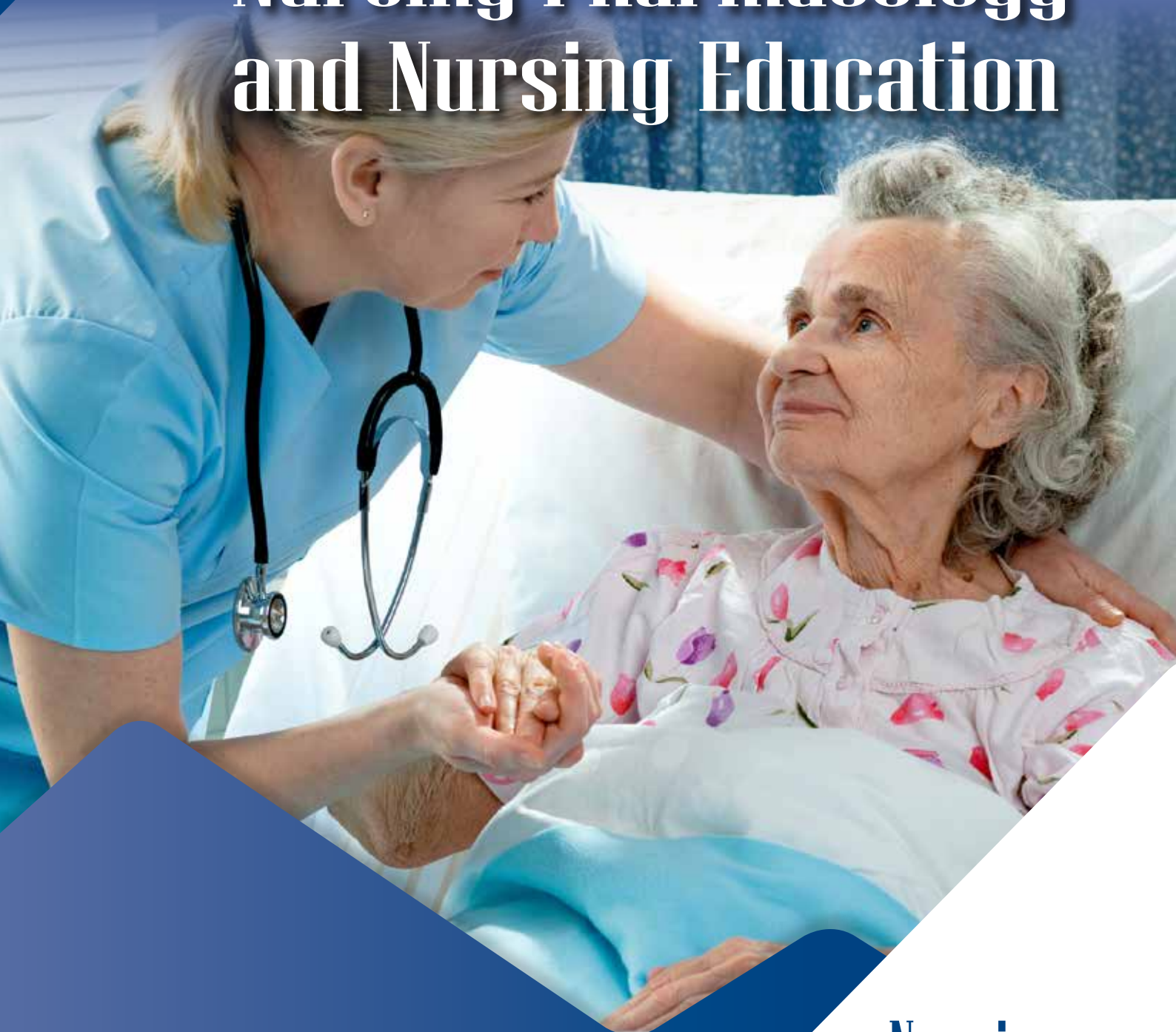

In the Southbank area, the Melbourne Arts Precinct is the site of Arts Centre Melbourne— a performing arts complex – and the National Gallery of Victoria, with Australian and indigenous art. Melbourne rates highly in education, entertainment, health care, research and development, tourism and sport, making it the world's most livable city—for the sixth year in a row in 2016, according to the Economist Intelligence Unit.
