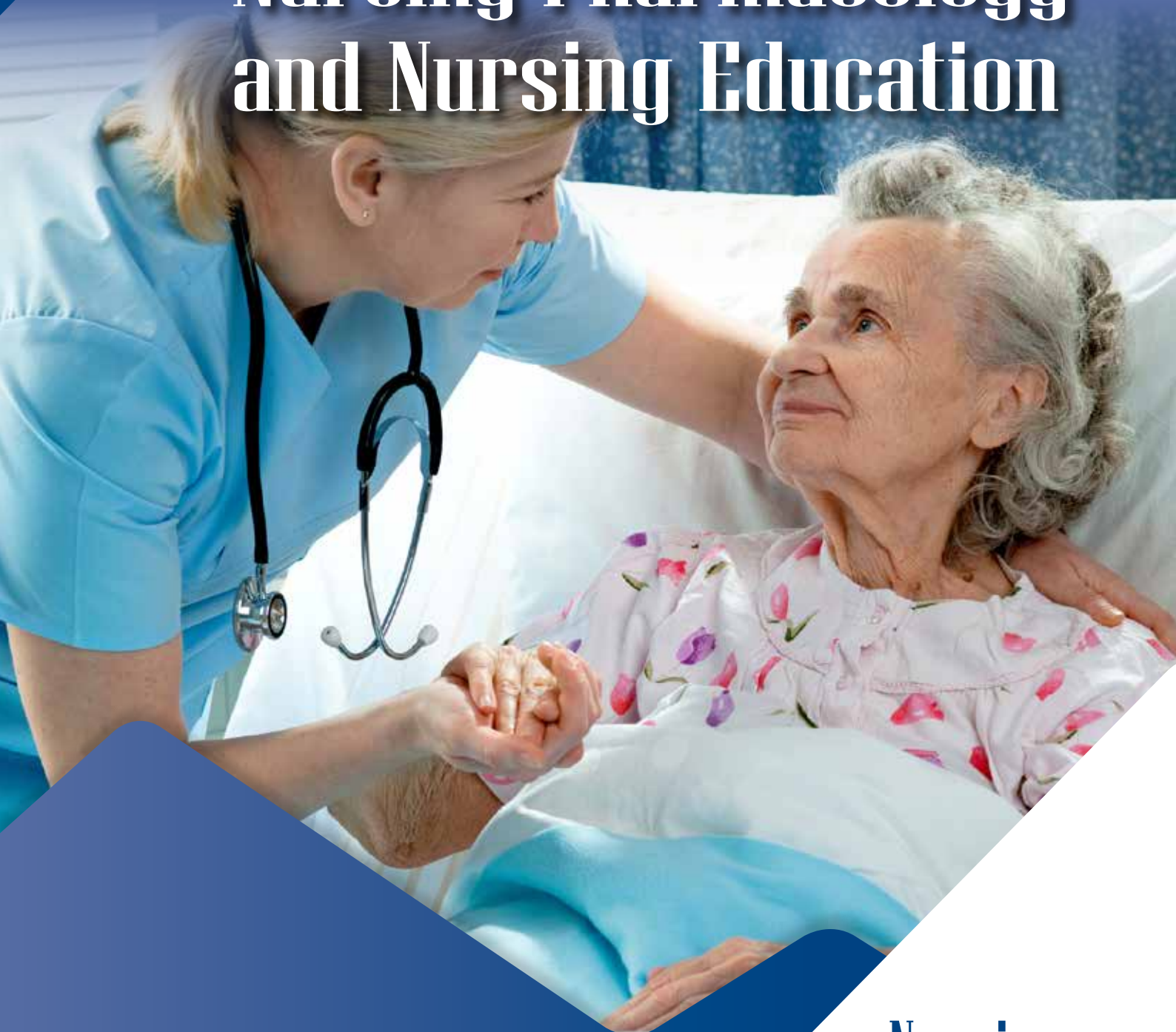

Melbourne rates highly in education, entertainment, health care, research and development, tourism and sport, making it the world's most livable city—for the sixth year in a row in 2016, according to the Economist Intelligence Unit.*
