Melbourne is the capital and most populous city in the Australian state of Victoria and the second most populous city in Australia and Oceania. The metropolis is located on the large natural bay of Port Phillip and expands into the hinterlands toward the Dandong and Macedon mountain ranges, Melbourne rates highly in education, entertainment, health care, research and development, tourism and sport, making it the world's most livable city—for the fifth year in a row in 2015, according to the Economist Intelligence Unit. It is a leading financial center in the Asia-Pacific region, and ranks among the top 30 cities in the world in the Global Financial Centers Index.

It is the birthplace of Australian impressionism, Australian Rule football, the Australian film and television industries, and Australian contemporary dance such as the Melbourne Shuffle. It is recognized as a UNESCO City of Literature and a major center for street art, music and theatre. It is home to many of Australia's largest and oldest cultural institutions such as the Australian Centre for the Moving Image, Melbourne Cricket Ground, the National Gallery of Victoria, the State Library of Victoria and the UNESCO World Heritage-listed Royal Exhibition Building. The main passenger airport serving the metropolis and the state is Melbourne Airport (also called Tullamarine Airport), which is the second busiest in Australia, and the Port of Melbourne is Australia's busiest seaport for containerized and general cargo Melbourne has an extensive transport network. Melbourne is also home to Australia's most extensive freeway network and has the world's largest urban tram network.
