The two main universities are the Université Libre de Bruxelles and the Vrije Universiteit Brussel. Other universities include the Université Saint-Louis Bruxelles, Katholieke Universiteit Leuven, the Royal Military Academy, Université Catholique de Louvain, the University of Kent's Brussels School of International Studies and Boston University Brussels. Serving as the centre of administration for Europe, Brussels' economy is largely service-oriented. The city of Brussels is now unforgettable as the city's utmost impressive parks in mainland Europe. There are so many tourist attractions in Brussels, few of which are Grand Place, Brussels Town Hall, Manneken-Pis, Heysel Park and the Atomium, Mini-Europe, etc.
