**About Madrid**

Madrid is the capital and largest city of Spain. It is the third-largest city in the European Union, after London and Berlin, and its metropolitan area is the third-largest in the European Union after Paris and London. The city is located on the Manzanares River in the centre of both the country and the Community of Madrid. As the capital city of Spain, seat of government, and residence of the Spanish monarch, Madrid is also the political, economic and cultural centre of Spain. Madrid is considered the major financial centre of Southern Europe and the Iberian Peninsula. Madrid possesses a modern infrastructure; it has preserved the look and feel of many of its historic neighborhood's and streets. Madrid is home to two world-famous football clubs, Real Madrid and Atlético de Madrid. Madrid became the capital of Spain in the 16th century; Madrid was more a centre of consumption than of production or trade.

Madrid is the European city with the highest number of trees and green surface per inhabitant and it has the second highest number of aligned trees in the world. It is considered one of the top European destinations concerning art museums. Best known is the Golden Triangle of Art, located along the Paseo del Prado and comprising three museums. Madrid has a considerable number of Catholic churches, some of them are among the most important Spanish religious artworks. For those who love nightlife, Madrid is one of the city's main attractions. Some of the most popular night destinations include the neighborhood's of Bilbao, Tribunal, Atocha, Alonso Martínez or Moncloa, together with the Puerta del Sol area (including Ópera and Gran Vía, both adjacent to the popular square) and Huertas (Barrio de las Letras), destinations which are also filled with tourists day and night.
