## About Las Vegas

The Las Vegas is one of the top three leading destinations in the United States for conventions, business, and meetings. There are about 26 Universities and Colleges in and around Las Vegas, which are working in the field of Respiratory, Lung Disease and Pulmonary Disorders. In 2009, 40.3 million Americans were diagnosed with asthma or chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD). Of these, 25.1 million had asthma and 15.1 million had COPD. The asthma/ COPD therapeutics market is growing, with a high amount of momentum coming from COPD, which has remained a relatively unknown disease.

## Why in Las Vegas?

- The city of Las Vegas is experiencing a hike in the spread of Lung disease, respiratory diseases and Pulmonary Disease due to pollution, in that prospective the market of pulmonary research and development is predicted to increase to a greater extent when compared to the past years report.
- New analysis from Frost & Sullivan's (pharma.frost.com) U.S. Asthma/COPD Market research finds that the market earned revenues of \$15.4 million in 2009 and estimates this to reach \$17.9 million in 2016.
- The global COPD market is estimated to currently be worth \$11.3 billion, and is forecast to reach a value of \$15.6 billion by 2019
- Between 3 and 7 million Americans are currently diagnosed with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), and the true prevalence is probably greater than 16 million. Many of these individuals suffer years of progressive discomfort and disability.
- With the number of deaths per year attributed to this disease at approximately 100,000 and increasing, COPD is now the fourth leading cause of death in this country and is expected to be third by the year 2020.
- Cigarette smoking is firmly established as the major cause of COPD, but approximately one-quarter of Americans continue to smoke, despite aggressive smoking prevention and cessation efforts.
- Hence various researches are funded in this area and many diagnostic methods are invented to take the pulmonary treatment to the next level.
