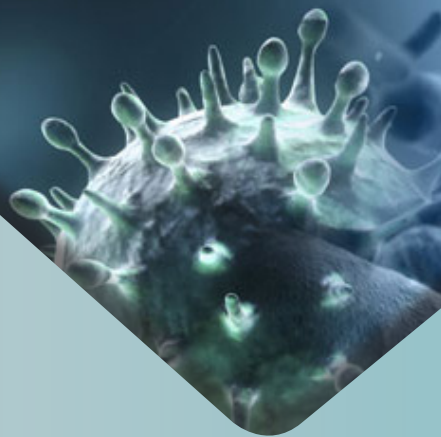
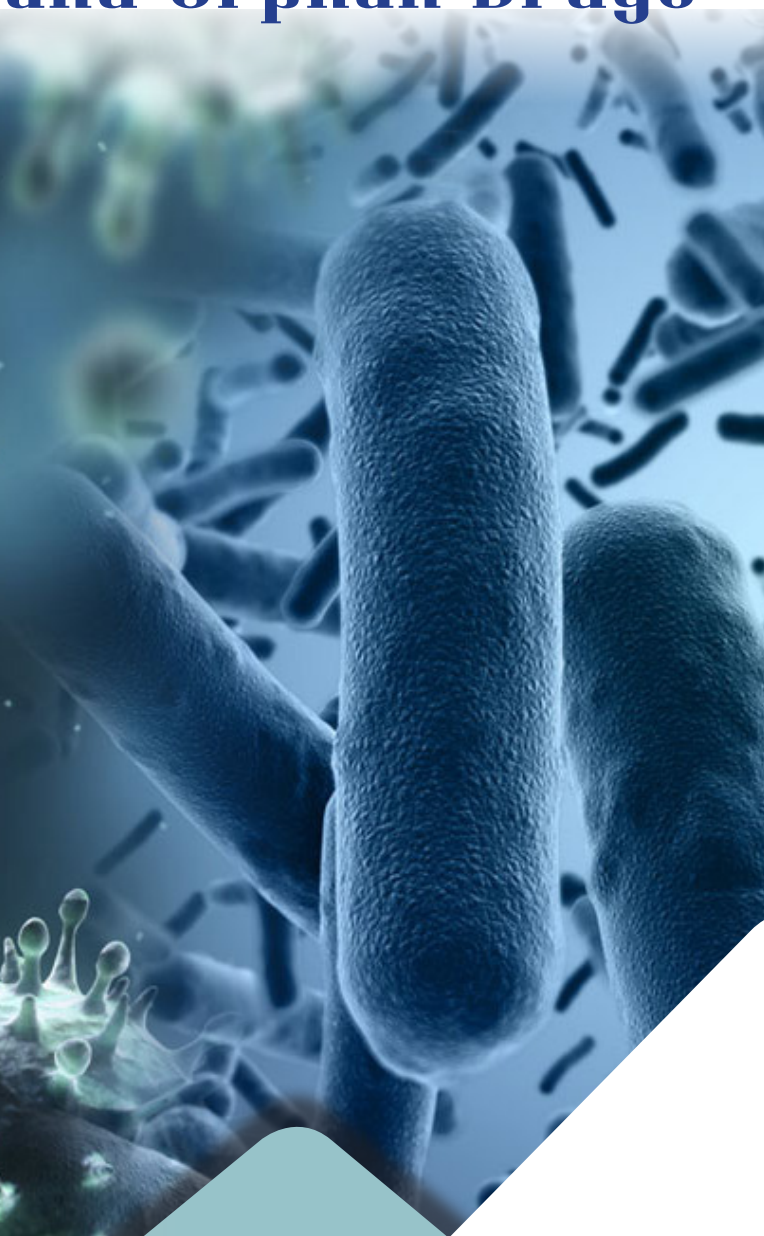
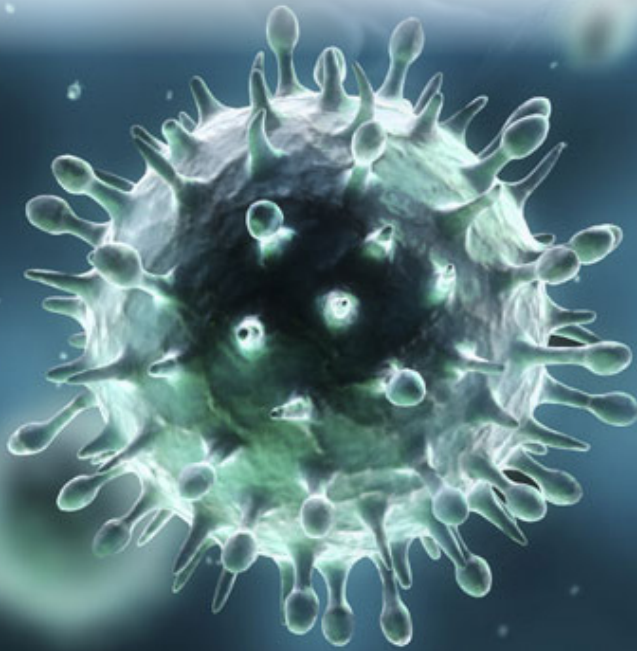

London is the largest city in Europe and located astride the famous river of Thames. The London Natural History Society suggests that London is "one of the World's Greenest Cities" with more than 40 % green space or open water.

The 2011 census recorded that 36.7% of London's population are foreign-born making London the city with the second largest immigrant population. The City of London, the capital of United Kingdom is a year-round tourist destination. This is the home for most of the international organizations. London generates about 20 per cent of the UK's GDP (2005); while the economy of the London metropolitan area-the largest in Europe generates about 30 per cent of the UK's GDP (2005).

As of 2015 London tops the world rankings on the global financial centres index. London is one of the leading tourist destinations in the world and in 2015 was ranked as the most visited city in the world with over 65 million visits. London is a major international air transport hub with the busiest city airspace in the world. London is a major global centre of higher education teaching and research and its 43 universities form the largest concentration of higher education institutes in Europe.

According to the QS World University Rankings 2015/16, London has the greatest concentration of top class universities in the world London has been the setting for many works of literature. The literary centres of London have traditionally been hilly Hampstead and (since the early 20th century) Bloomsbury. London is home to many museums, galleries like Buckingham Palace, Tower of London, Tower Bridge, Natural History museum and other institutions, many of which are free of admission charges and are major tourist attractions as well as playing a research role.
