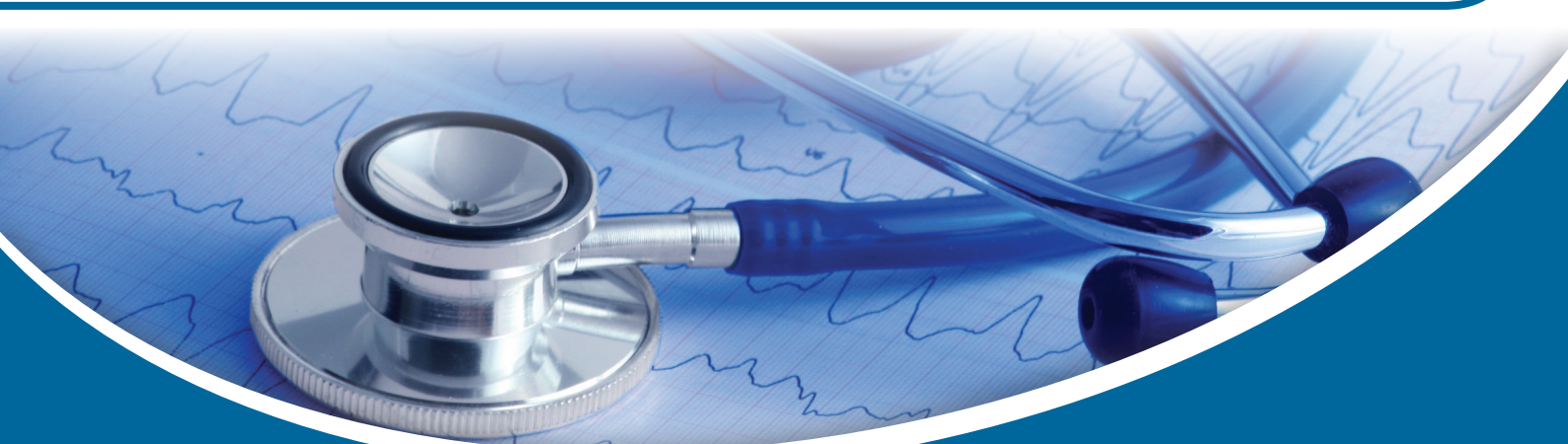

## About Berlin, Germany

Berlin is the capital of Germany, and one of the 16 states of Germany. With a population of 3.5 million people, Berlin is Germany's largest city. It is the second most populous city proper and the seventh most populous urban area in the European Union and one of the most prolific centers of higher education and research in Europe.

The history of science in Berlin is full of the names of famous scholars like Humboldt, Einstein, Virchow, Koch, Meitner and Planck. Major national research organizations such as Fraunhofer, the Helmholtz Association and the Leibniz Association are represented in Berlin by various institutions and research sites. Germany's largest concentration of universities and colleges is located in Berlin, a leading center of science, academics, and research, not least thanks to its 39 institutions of higher education. Germany's national research organizations are represented in Berlin with a number of institutes, as are eight federal ministry research facilities.

Together with Berlin's universities, nearly 100 research institutions in the city form an important basis for the region's economic development. The economic effects are enormous for Berlin: Through seminar and conference events, the capital was able to book 7 million overnight stays, roughly 25% of all hotel overnights in Berlin. With revenue reaching 2 billion euros, roughly 38,000 full-time jobs are secured through seminar and conference traffic. Berlin contains many famous tourism attractions like Brandenburg Gate; Reichstag Building; Museum Island; Berlin Wall; Checkpoint Charlie; Pergamon Museum; Charlottenburg Palace; Neues Museum; Berlin Cathedral; Friedrichstraße; Berlin Zoological Garden; Kurfürstendamm; Treptower Park; AquaDom and many more...
