Health share of GDP will continue its historical upward trend, reaching 19.5% of GDP by 2017. USA hospital care expenditure is \$850.6 Billion and the gross output of USA hospitals is around \$664,764 Million. The total number of USA registered hospital is around 5,723 while the number of USA community hospital is 4,999. USA healthcare spending per capita is \$8508 where public spending is \$4066, private spending is \$3454 and out of pocket spending is \$987.

Healthcare spending in USA by types of services:

- Hospitals - 27.1 %
- Physician Services - 22.6%
- Pharmaceuticals - 12.9%
- Home Healthcare - 2.4%

Others - 35% (that includes long term institutional care, dental, clinical laboratory, diagnostic imaging, patient transport, emergency rescue administration and R & D).

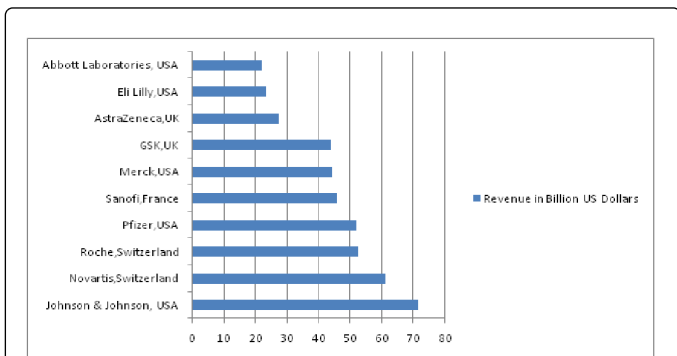

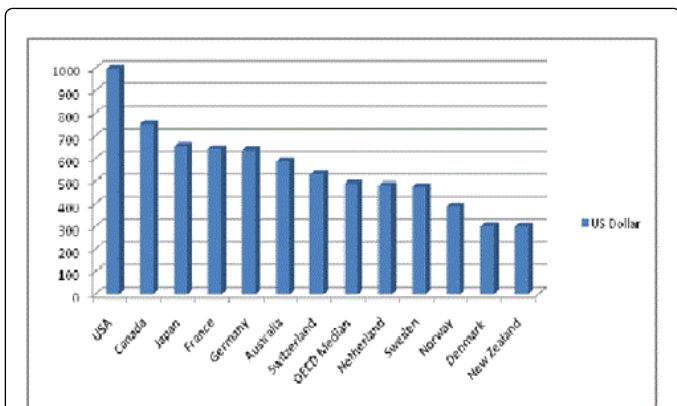

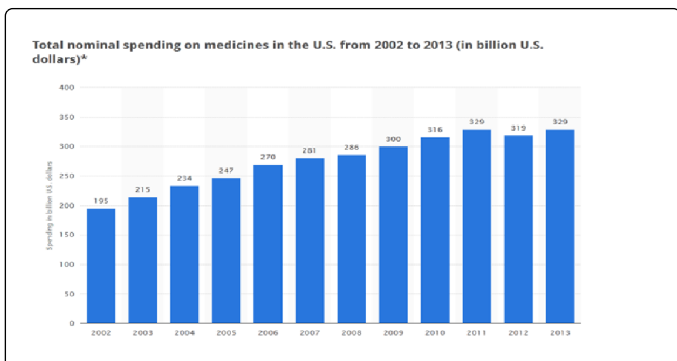
