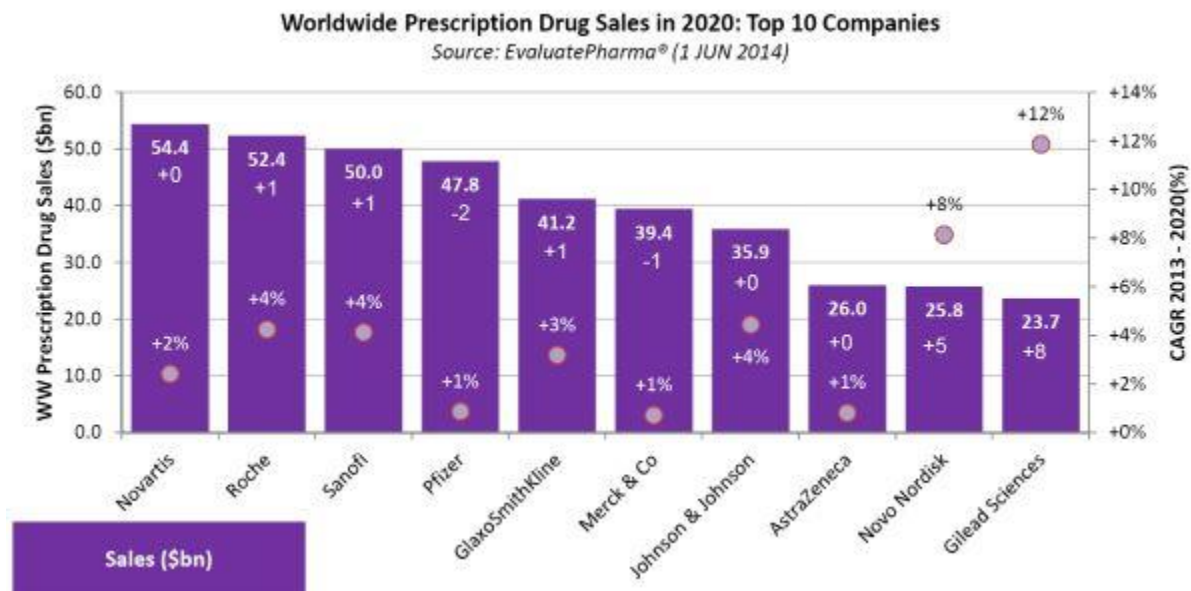


Figure 1: 2014 ranking of the global top 10 Healthcare Companies

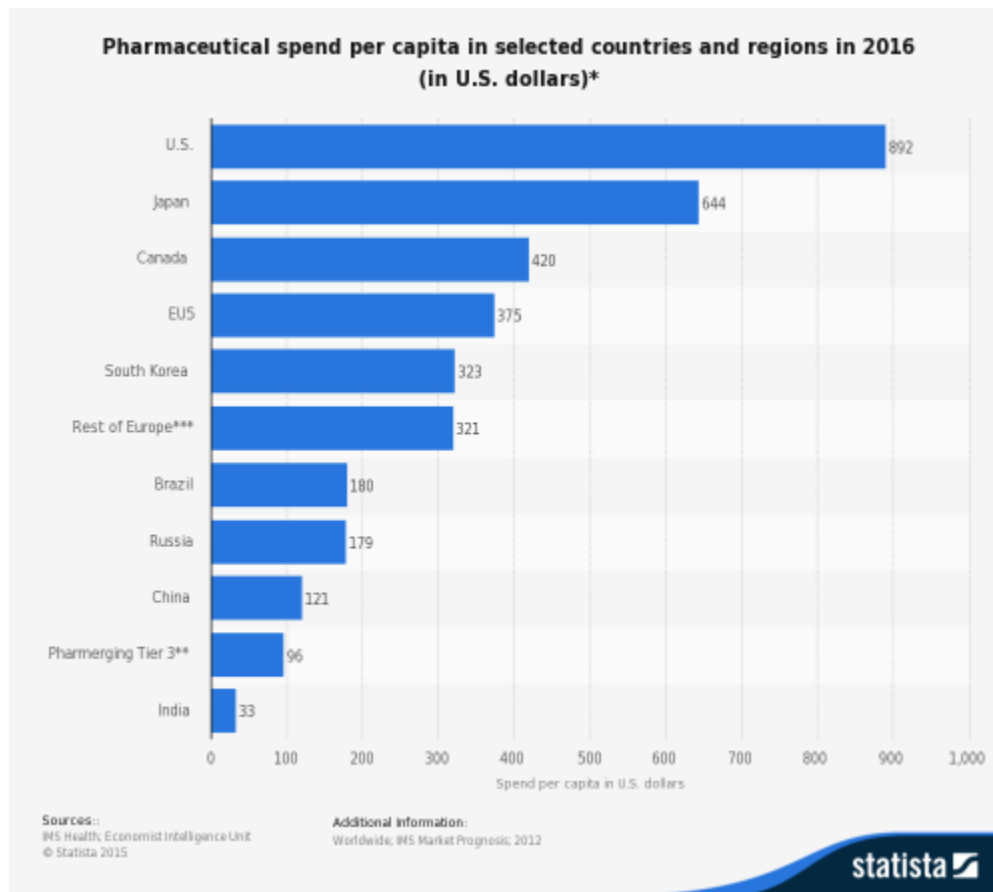


Figure 2: Pharmaceutical Spending Per Capita
